

What is CHAMPs?

CHAMPs is a proactive and positive approach to classroom management training that is researched based. It is a comprehensive series of trainings and resources for those teachers who want to design or fine tune their classroom management plan that will overtly teach students how to behave responsibly.

Underlying beliefs include:

- All students must be treated with dignity and respect
- Students should be taught the skills and behaviors necessary for success
- Motivation and responsibility should be encouraged through positive interaction and building relationships with students
- Student misbehavior represents a teaching opportunity
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Key Benefits of CHAMPs:

- Teachers establish clear expectations with logical and fair responses to misbehavior
- Teachers spend less time disciplining and more time teaching
- Teachers learn tools to motivate students to do their best
- Students are taught how to behave responsibly

Objectives: Participants will learn...

- to assess the level of structure needed (high, medium, low) that will meet the needs of any particular group of students
- to implement classroom strategies in order to create a management plan that will correspond to their students need for structure
- to self-assess and (as necessary) implement a wide range of classroom management and behavior management strategies
- to use non-evaluative peer coaching methods to assist in implementing effective classroom management strategies.
